

INVERGORDON ACADEMY DRESS CODE

We strongly believe that pupils should adhere to the Dress Code outlined below for the following of reasons:

- On the grounds of security since we are able to identify any intruders immediately and easily.
- We believe that pupils should identify with the school and, when consulted, they prefer the school Dress Code.
- The ethos of the school is enhanced when pupils are in Dress Code
- It precludes the wearing of designer or casual clothing which is expensive and can encourage competition or confrontation.

Invergordon Academy Dress Code

All pupils at Invergordon Academy are expected to wear the dress code at all times throughout the term including examination periods. Most items of clothing can be purchased from the school.

Details of the Dress Code are given below:

1. All pupils must display the school logo as part of their daily dress.
2. All pupils receive a free school tie when they arrive at the school. Wearing of the school tie is an optional part of the school dress code.
3. All pupils must wear a white or black shirt/tee-shirt. Shirts/tee shirts must be worn at a sensible length.
4. Pupils should wear plain, black skirts or trousers. Skirts must be worn at a sensible length.
5. There is no restriction on pupil's shoes other than on health & safety grounds.
6. Hair should be clean and neat, with no excessive hair colourings.
7. Headwear may only be worn in school for religious or health grounds.
8. The only items of jewellery permitted are watches, rings, and stud earrings.

The following items are **not** acceptable in school:

1. Blue jeans or any item of denim clothing.
2. Baseball caps.
3. Excessive items of jewellery.

These lists have been put together as a guide for staff, pupils and parents. Inevitably there will be times when further guidance will be required. In these situations pupils or parents should be referred to the SMT.
